



# Coffee Rota & Social Committee

## *What does the Social Committee do?*

Members are responsible for organising social events within the Parish, including the Harvest Lunch, Quiz Night etc. The Committee also arranges the weekly refreshments in the Church Hall, following the roam service.

## *How much time is involved?*

Coffee rota duties usually come round three or four times a year. There are three or four other social events per year. People on the coffee rota do not necessarily have to be involved in the other events.
