



Intercessors

What do Intercessors do?

Intercessors prepare and lead the prayers at the 10am Parish Communion on Sundays. They can use the set or traditional forms of prayer or take a more individual approach. They liaise with the Vicar or Parish Secretary before hand to find out if there are any particular people or concerns that need including in that week's prayers. The intercessions do not have to be terribly long, and spaces and silence within them can be very effective.

How much time is involved?

Most intercessors lead the prayers twice a year. Preparing the prayers requires some time and care.

What is worthwhile or enjoyable about this activity?

The intercessions are a very significant part of the service, and it is lovely to have them vary in feel and style each week as different people lead them. Well led prayers are a real blessing and are greatly appreciated.

Are there any particular skills or abilities that are helpful for volunteers to have?

The ability to cope with the microphone and to speak clearly is a definite plus.
